

2009 Fall Season Requirements

U11/U12 Classic A Season

We are transitioning into a new format for selecting seasonal play, starting with U11/U12. This was voted on and passed at the June 2009 East Central Board Meeting. In the new LeagueOne system U11 and U12 teams wishing to play both Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 soccer will select Classic A for scheduling purposes. These teams will be put into a division that will stay together for both the Fall and Spring season. U11 and U12 teams will not be offered the scrimmage option. U13/U14 & Higher

These age brackets are not included in the Classic A phase in process for 2009/2010. Teams will have two options; **Scheduled Games or Scrimmages.**

- If a team opts to have their games scheduled they must register with their club and have their club registrar submit their teams for scheduling through the LeagueOne program. Registrar will select Classic B when registering these teams for the fall season. These teams may or may not be scheduled to play together for the Spring Season. Clubs will submit with additional teams for Spring 2010 and East Central will hold the pre-scheduling meeting February 24, 2010 for all teams playing within the B or C levels Spring 2010. If a team opts for scheduled games, games will be scheduled according to the guidelines listed below.
- If a team opts to do scrimmages, the coach or contact persons will be provided with information to contact other teams. Each coach will need to make their own arrangements regarding who to play, field, etc. A referee will not be required. All players must be registered for the 2009/2010 soccer season in order to play scrimmages. Being a registered player will provide insurance coverage for all players.

Providing there are enough teams to make a schedule viable, a fall league will be generated for U13, U14 teams both coed & girls. Scheduled games will be played at 2:00 PM or 3:30 PM starting September 13th and continuing each week until six games have been scheduled or each team plays the other once. If necessary, some games may be scheduled on Saturday, ensuring that the games end no later than October 18, 2009. Should your home field or teams be unavailable for one of the weeks, due to tournaments, please provide that information. This information must be provided within the LeagueOne Software.

All players must be registered with your club. Those that are playing scheduled games must be on a roster and have ID cards. Teams that are rostered for the fall league will have their players cards issued for the August 1, 2009-July 31, 2010 soccer season. The team that you put together for the fall season will be the same team for spring/summer season of 2010. Should you need to make roster changes please consult the guidelines for making such changes.

There will be no additional East Central charges, however **your club will be responsible for referee fees, field stripping or field charges.**

Information Due August 10, 2009

As a safe guard, all East Central clubs MUST submit their fall league intentions (league games or scrimmages) lists to Sue Ann Evers via e-mail and/or excel spread sheet. This will serve as a double check against our new scheduling process with LeagueOne.

Scheduled

All clubs that are interested in scheduled games must provide team scheduling information through LeagueOne.
